Tamali Saha's Garam Masala Chai

There are typically four components in Masala Chai and the secret is finding the perfect blend for your taste. Masala goes well with tea biscuits , savory crispy crunch baked goods Here's the recipe I used for our partea.

The quantity I have here makes 2 cups of tea:

Black Tea - 1/2 tsp loose leaf

I Whole Cardamom, I/2

I tsp fresh grated ginger

Whole Spices - 2 tsp Fennel seeds

I lyth pinch of nutmeg

I tsp fresh grated ginger

I/2 cup Milk (or nut milk)

Sweetener of choice as per taste

Steps: 1. Lightly crush the whole spices in a mortar pestle or spice grinder 2. Boil 1.5 cup of water with the grated ginger. After a minute of boil, turn the stove off. Add the ground spices, black tea, and cover the pot with a lid and let it sit for 5 minutes 3. Add sweetener and milk. Turn on the stove and simmer over med-low heat for a minute or two, until a few gentle bubbles appear 4. Strain into a teapot or into tea cups and enjoy Garam Masala Chai. -Guest Speaker & Co-Treasurer Tamali Saha
